Is there a significant correlation between students' grades English and their grades Algorithm when Algorithm is taught in English?


Limitation


Algorithm was taught in English in term 1 and 3, before students had finished their intensive English course.


The Sample is to small

Method


- Questionaire

- All the data was transcribed and analyzed.









Students' Preferred Language of instruction






Number of Students in Each Final English level in Term 3



Final English level with Letter Grades 14 Pre-Intermediate 12 High 10 8 Pre-Intermediate Mid Pre-Intermediate Low Failed B


